Susie A. Clark, 82, of Bonita Springs, FL passed away peacefully on Monday, August 17, 2015 at her residence surrounded by her loving family. Formerly of Muncie, IN, Indianapolis, IN, and Rochester, MI, she had been a resident of Bonita Springs since 2001.

Susie was born January 26, 1933 in Brooklyn, NY a daughter of the late Jacob and Laura (Lorentzen) Bonshire. She was raised in Muncie and graduated from Muncie Central High School in 1950.
