Terrence “Terry” Edwin Pressel, age 75, formerly of West Milton, Ohio passed away peacefully on November 19, 2014 at Joanne’s Hospice House of Bonita Springs, Florida. Born in Piqua, Ohio, October 19, 1939, Terry graduated from Milton-Union High School class of 1957. He served five years in the U.S. Navy and retired in 1993 after 30 years of service as a Sr. Controls Design Eng. From G.M. Dayton/Vandalia.
