Thomas W. Banaszewski, age 77, of Estero, FL formally of Webster, NY, peacefully passed away with family close by on Tuesday, February 20, 2018. He was the beloved husband for over 54 years to his wife Nancy.

Tom was born and raised in Schenectady, NY on November 25, 1940, son of the late William and Anne Banaszewski. He was a graduate of Ricker College and was extremely active in local politics and the community. While he had many business accomplishments he was most proud of paving the way for women in business by driving the Rochester Jaycees to allow female members in the early 1970's.
