Thomas P. Roettele, 80 of Naples, FL died Sunday, February 13, 2022 at Naples Community Hospital. Formerly of Cincinnati, OH he moved to Stuart, FL in 1978 before relocating to Marco Island, FL in 1985 and ultimately calling Naples home in 1993.
