Thomas J. Tortorice, 89, of Bonita Springs, FL, passed away on Wednesday, May 23, 2018. Formerly of Mayfield Heights, OH, he had been a Bonita Springs resident for the last 30 years. He was born February 5, 1929 in Steubenville, OH, the son of Domenico “Tom” and Lena (née DiLeonardo) Tortorice.
