Timothy James O'Rourke, 66, of Bonita Springs, FL, died Wednesday, January 28, 2015. Formerly of Chicago and Peoria, IL, he had been a seasonal resident of Bonita Springs since 2002. He was born May 29, 1948 in Chicago, the son of Timothy Francis and Kathleen Dorothy (née Thompson) O'Rourke.

He was owner and President of Naab & O'Rourke Insurancenter before retiring in 2010. Tim was much loved and respected by his business colleagues and friends in Peoria and Chicago, and especially by his Quincy University fellow alums.
