Victorina T. Carpenter, 97, of Naples FL passed away Sunday, November 27, 2016 at North Collier Florida Hospital. A resident of Virginia for 50 years, she resided at Lake of the Woods for 15 years before moving permanently to Florida in 1995.

Vicki was born April 13, 1919 in Mark, IL a daughter of the late Joseph and Albina (Bettochi) Tulini. She graduated from Hopkins High School in 1937. She moved to Washington, D.C. during World War II where she met her future husband, William "Bill" Carpenter. Her career was spent working as an Administrative Officer for the Atomic Energy Commission in Washington, D.C. for over 35 before retiring at the age of 62. Vicki has been known to say that "there was a time where everybody in Washington, D.C. knew who Vicki Carpenter was." Vicki loved to entertain and ride their pontoon boat around the lake at Lake of the Woods. Vicki was an avid golfer who in her lifetime made 3 hole-in-ones. She also enjoyed fitness and teaching an aerobics class at Bentley Village.

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by her husband of 60 years, William W. Carpenter; brother, Deno Tulini; and sister, Margaret Bonucchi. She is survived by many loving nieces and nephews.
