VIVIAN MARIE FANA DOLAN, AGE 101, PASSED AWAY PEACEFULLY ON FEBRUARY 13, 2020 AT HOPE HOSPICE, BONITA SPRINGS, FLORIDA. SHE WAS MARRIED TO JOSEPH FANA (DECEASED) FOR 58 YEARS. IN 2001 SHE MARRIED CLEO B. DOLAN (DECEASED).

BORN IN ST. AGATA, SICILY IN 1918, VIVIAN CAME TO AMERICA AT 14 MONTHS AND BECAME A CITIZEN IN 1931. HER PARENTS WERE CHARLES AND JOSEPHINE FAZIO. SHE AND HER HUSBAND JOSEPH WORKED WITH THE FAZIO FAMILY DEVELOPING THE FAZIO GROCERY CHAIN THAT GREW TO BE ON THE NEW YORK STOCK EXCHANGE.
