Walter D. Scott, 89, of Naples, FL died Friday, January 23, 2015 at The Aristocrat. Formerly of Phoenix, AZ he had been a resident of Naples since 2002. Walter was born July 19, 1925 in Brooklyn, NY a son of the late Walter P. and Anna E. (Clabby) Scott.
