



Wesley R. "Buddy" Rosier

November 7, 1926 - August 9, 2021

Wesley R. "Buddy" Rosier 94, of Naples died unexpectedly on August 9, 2021 at his residence. Buddy was born on November 7, 1926 in Manatee, FL a son of the late Malcom and Laura (Parrish) Rosier. He had been a resident of Naples since 1951 coming from Bradenton, FL.

Buddy attended Manatee County High School and in his senior year, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy and proudly served his country until July of 1946. After returning home he finished his high school education and attended the University of Tampa where he received his Associate's degree.

On July 18, 1948 he married the love of his life, Margaret C. Benson in Manatee, FL. They had 68 wonderful years of marriage until her passing in 2017.

After moving to Naples, Buddy and Margaret's late uncle, Robert T. Benson, Sr. formed the Benson Insurance Agency. He retired from the agency in 1974. One not to sit idle, he was a partner in the Witt-Rosier Realty in Naples Park and in his later years assisted his son Bob at the Rosier-Turner Insurance Agency.

He was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Naples, the American Legion Post 135, the Lions Club of Naples and a founding member

of the North Naples Rotary Club.

He is survived by his son and daughter-in-law, Richard R. "Bob" Rosier and his wife, Kathleen D. Rosier of Naples, FL; three granddaughters, Charisse R. Nabors and her husband, Robert of Ft. Myers, FL, Lauren A. Joynt and her fiancé, Tony Raiano of Naples, FL and Alicia R. Stevens and her husband, Paul of Naples, FL and three great-grandchildren, Chloe M. Nabors, Daniel B. Nabors and Shelby L. Stevens.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his beloved wife, Margaret C. Rosier who died February 15, 2017, his son, David Wayne Rosier who died November 4, 1973, his brother, Earl Rosier and his sister, Evelyn Cumbie.

A Memorial Service to celebrate his life will be held at 11:00 AM on Saturday, September 18, 2021 in the Village Chapel at the North Naples Church 6000 Goodlette Rd., Naples, FL 34109. Military honors will be provided by the United States Navy.

Buddy will be laid to rest next to his late wife at Sarasota National Cemetery, Sarasota, FL.
